Schedule Changes

In an effort to provide a consistent learning experience for students during the remainder of the third quarter, **schedule changes will only be processed to bring students back to campus or for temporary COVID-related isolations and quarantine.** If you wish to make a schedule change for the fourth quarter please contact Ms. Stacy Miller at smiller@stmdphs or Mr. Marcus Prewitt at mprewitt@stmdphs.org. Additional considerations and scheduling updates:

- Anyone wishing to participate in on-campus activities during the spring season (such as baseball, softball, and track & field) *must* attend on campus, in-person learning *before* the start of their season.
- Students enrolled in in-person classes are expected to show up to school daily, and will be marked absent if not physically present in class.

Reminders for In-Person Learning:

- Please remember to complete your COVID-19 Questionnaire in PowerSchool every morning before coming to school - if you answer YES to any of the questions, please stay home and notify the school of your absence to be marked excused for the day.
- If you or someone in your family has received a COVID-19 test, please stay home and notify the school. We will work with you during this time and if you must isolate or quarantine to ensure the health of safety of everyone on campus and to ensure you receive the academic support you need while out of class.

Incomplete Classes & Credit Recovery:

Students who received an "I" or Incomplete on their report cards have until **Friday January 22th for Seniors and Friday March 19th for all other students** to complete their missing or incomplete work to avoid attending summer school. Student Success Coaches are working with students on campus to complete these requirements. Remote Learning students should contact their teachers and attend Office Hours (Tuesday through Friday from 3:30 to 4:30 PM) for more information and support.
