Pick-up will take place from the back driveway to the St. Clair building and food packs will be brought to your car to limit the number of visitors in the school building.



Creating Safe & Equitable Access to Cleveland's East Side Lakefront Parks & Trail

Bike Cleveland has recently launched an initiative called Creating Safe & Equitable Access to Cleveland's East Side Lakefront as part of the Safe Routes to Parks Activating Communities



As Cleveland's lakefront is one of its greatest assets, we want everyone in our community to have safe and easy access to it.

Why Safe Routes to Parks?

Parks provide a place for people to be active, spend time in nature, and connect with neighbors and friends but not everyone has safe, easy access to walk, bike, and roll to local parks. But our streets must be designed with sidewalks, crosswalks, better street lighting and reduced traffic speeds. Over the long term, with increased safety and accessibility, Safe Routes to Parks will increase park usage and improve health for people of all ages, races, abilities, and income levels.



Activating Communities Program

From a competitive pool of nationwide applicants. Safe Routes Partnership has selected Bike Cleveland to join Safe Routes to Parks Activating Communities, a technical assistance program focused on improving safe and equitable local park access. With funding from The JPB Foundation, Safe Routes to Parks Activating Communities supports collaboration among local partners to ensure that children and adults can easily and safely walk, bike, or roll to local parks and green spaces. As part of the program, the St. Clair Superior neighborhood in Cleveland, Ohio is one of eight diverse communities across the country receiving coaching from Safe Routes National Partnership to develop an action plan for improving active travel to local parks and green spaces and implement early actions from the plan.
