A Unique Educational Model

Saint Martin de Porres High School is a Catholic, co-educational, college preparatory school located in the St. Clair-Superior neighborhood of Cleveland. Saint Martin was opened in 2004 and is chartered by the state of Ohio and accredited through the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association. Our students exclusively come from families of limited economic means.

As a member of the national Cristo Rey Network of schools, Saint Martin partners with over 120 local organizations that are committed to educating our students through Corporate Work Study. Students work in entry-level positions one full day a week (five full days a month) gaining 1,600 hours of real-world work experience by graduation and earning nearly 20% of the cost of their own education.

Combining a rigorous, college-preparatory curriculum with professional work experience, Saint Martin is committed to the values of Work, Study, Serve, Lead and Pray. We provide a caring, safe environment dedicated to helping students become college ready, career prepared, and ready for life.

About the Cristo Rey Network

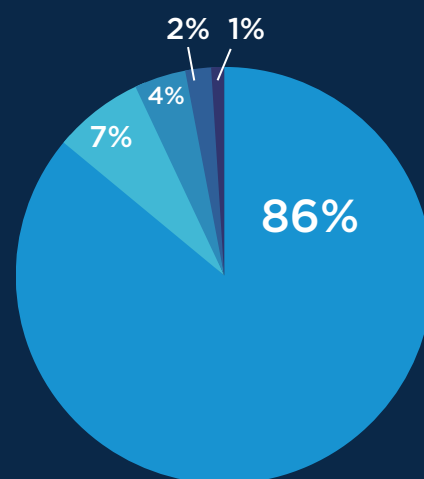

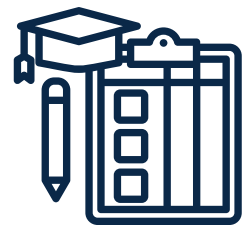

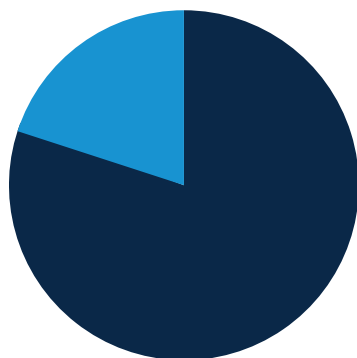

College Matriculation Data

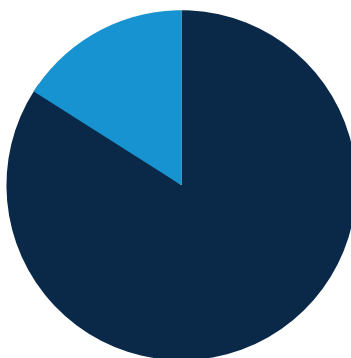
Total Number of Students in Class of 2023 = 75

4Y Enrollment



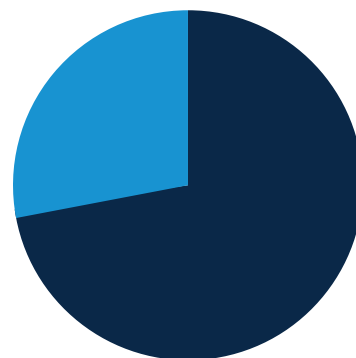
