WORK

Make-Up Time Policies

Per our student handbook, **ALL missed CWSP workdays will require make-up time** to be completed by June 2022. *Failure to complete make-up time will result in dismissal from Saint Martin.* Below, please find the specific attendance and make-up time policy and the Senior make-up time policy as stated in the student handbook:

- **SENIORS** - Seniors will not be allowed to attend Prom OR Graduation without standing make-up time. Please be sure to be proactive and get your make-up time completed as soon as possible.

CWSP Workday Attendance Policy & Responsibilities

- Students are expected to attend work every scheduled work date.
- Each student works only five days per month. Missing a day of work is a very serious event.
- Saint Martin de Porres High School and the student promise the company that they will fulfill their work responsibilities for the entire school year

Definition of Missed Work Time

- Any hour or day not worked on the student's scheduled workday (Hours and half days of missed work will accrue and are included in the student's total absences)
- All missed hours/days must be made up according to the schedule below entitled MAKE-UP TIME
- If a student will be absent on a workday, parents/guardians must call the CWSP Hotline at 216-346-7896 before 8:00 AM.

Please note, confirmed positive covid cases requiring isolation will be exempt from CWSP make-up time.

Sign Up for Make-up Time

- When a student is absent, they will receive an email from "notifications@workstudyforce.com"
- Students must REQUEST a specific make-up day. The request will be sent to your supervisor for approval.
- Please note, students may only request make-up time when school is NOT in session.
- Here are some upcoming opportunities for make-up time:
 - **Monday, February 21** (President's Day - No transportation available)
 - **Friday, March 11** (Spring Break - NO transportation available)
 - **Monday, March 14** (Spring Break - Transportation **IS** available)
 - **Tuesday, March 15** (Spring Break - Transportation **IS** available)
 - **Wednesday, March 16** (Spring Break - Transportation **IS** available)
 - **Thursday, March 17** (Spring Break - No transportation available)

- **Friday, March 18** (Spring Break - No transportation available)
- If you need transportation for your CWSP make-up day, students must do two things:
 - Request a make-up day when transportation is available.
 - Email Ms. Natalie Brickman that you will need transportation (nbrickman@stmdphs.org)
