Juniors will take the PSAT on Tuesday, October 26 at 7:30 AM. It is critical that juniors are ON TIME to school, or else they may not be able to test.

The PSAT/NMSQT is one of our most critical practice steps along the way toward preparing to do our very best on the SAT. The SAT is accepted at all U.S. colleges; it measures what students are learning in high school and what they need to know to succeed in college and career.
