[PSAT for 9th & 10th Grade: Wed. Oct. 13](#)

All 9th and 10th grade students will be taking the PSAT in school on Wednesday, October 13th. This is a critical opportunity for students to prepare for the SAT college entrance exam in their Junior Year, which determines not only college admissions but equally important eligibility for college scholarships. Please talk to your son or daughter about the importance of taking this test seriously. **Students should come to school rested with their school assigned calculators and be on time @ 7:50 am.** There will be no make-up test date.

[Satisfactory Academic Progress](#)

Satisfactory Academic Progress is a term used to describe to whether or not a student is on track to graduate. Saint Martin de Porress, like colleges and universities around the country, uses Satisfactory Academic Progress to determine whether students remain eligible for continued enrollment.

At Saint Martin Satisfactory Academic Progress means maintaining better than a 2.5 cumulative GPA and having no more than 1F within an academic year. In order to support students meeting their graduation requirements, Saint Martin places any student with 2 or more F's or less than a 2.5 cumulative GPA (B/C average) on Academic Probation.

Students on Academic Probation are required to attend After School Office Hours in the classes they failed as well as meet or exceed attendance expectations to remain enrolled at Saint Martin.

Any student with 5 or more semester F's in a single academic year or failing to meeting the conditions of the Academic Probation will be dismissed from Saint Martin.

College Counseling Updates

FAFSA NOW OPEN!

FAFSA is open, so senior families should begin to gather their 2020 1040 tax forms and W-2s. This application must be completed to receive financial aid for college, and it is a graduation requirement. College Counselors are available to assist with FAFSA completion.
