

- Students will be provided with an additional week of extended time to complete missed schoolwork.




Senior Portraits THIS MONDAY!

Life of St. Martin de Porres

Martin became a barber's apprentice, a profession which at the time combined haircutting with surgical and medical skills. He was very skillful and was eventually put in charge of the clinic. He developed his own herbal remedies and homemade medications. Even though he was an expert in his field, he was also very humble. The broom represents how St. Martin was always willing to do any task asked of him, including simple cleaning chores.

According to sources, St. Martin had a special relationship with animals - he would speak to them and they would listen. Once in the kitchen, one of the monks was surprised to discover a dog, a cat and a mouse, all eating simultaneously from the same bowl that Martin had provided – an image of the "peaceable kingdom" that flourished in his presence.

St. Martin de Porres is the patron saint of social justice, racial harmony, and mixed race people.
