#### Attendance Reminder!

Being present at school and in classes is a key indicator of academic success. As a school we are averaging about 95.9% daily attendance which has declined over the past few weeks. **Our goal is to be at 97% daily attendance.** Please ensure you are doing your best to come to school each day.

#### **Food Delivery at Saint Martin**

This is a reminder that students are NOT allowed to order from food delivery services during the school day. Nor are they allowed to have food sent to them by a family member.

We have Door Dash Passes that are earned as incentives and can only be used during student's lunch periods. Without one, ordering food delivery is prohibited.

Families are able to drop off lunch in person during the students' lunch period.

We will not allow students to leave class to retrieve food during the day. If food is sent to the school without authorization from the school administration, the food will be held and stored until the end of the school day.
