Sign UP! CWS Make-Up Day Policy

All makeup days must be made up during holiday and school breaks, and completed by June 21, 2024 (or prior to participation in Saint Martin Prom and Graduation for students in the class of 2024). You are responsible for scheduling makeup time for your missed days. **If you need help signing up please stop by the CWS office and speak to Ms.G.**

Failure to complete makeup time by this deadline will result in an \$100 charge per incomplete day AND an incomplete make-up time termination. Failure to make-up your missed time and turn your make-up form in by paying \$100 for each missed day is not an option instead of making up the missed time.

COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA NOW!

The 2024-2025 FAFSA is open. All seniors must complete this application as it is a graduation/prom requirement and needed to receive financial aid for college. Parents will need an FSA ID. College counselors are available to assist with this application.

We recommend students do not make their college commitment until they have reviewed their financial aid award letters. These will be available in late March or early April because of the delay in FAFSA this year.


