COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA NOW!

The 2024-2025 FAFSA is open. All seniors must complete this application as it is a graduation/prom requirement and needed to receive financial aid for college. Parents will need an FSA ID. College counselors are available to assist with this application.

We recommend students do not make their college commitment until they have reviewed their financial aid award letters. These will be available in late March or early April because of the delay in FAFSA this year.

College Counselors are available to meet with families to review award letters and the college decision process.

Attention 11th Grade Students: Immunizations

Re-enrollment will launch in a few weeks to secure your student's seat at Saint Martin. As part of that process, all current 11th grade students will need to show proof of meningitis vaccine. The Ohio Revised Code requires all rising seniors to have a meningitis vaccine before returning to school in their senior year. Your student may have already received these immunizations at a previous medical appointment around the age of 16; please call to verify with your physician and obtain a copy of your immunization records to upload during re-enrollment.

OHSAA Sports Physicals

Spring sports have begun. Our spring sports include baseball, softball, boys & girls track, and boys volleyball. In order for students to participate in spring sports, students must have an up to date (within the last 12 months) <u>OHSAA Sports Physical</u> on file with the school. Metro Health will

Athletic & Performancce Group Eligibility

Our school's policy on academic eligibility for sports & performance groups is checked at the end of every quarter. Quarter 3 ends on Friday, March 8th.
