TWO-STEP RE-ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Please Note: All Financial Aid Commitments MUST BE PAID IN FULL prior to re-enrollment. Until the balance of your scholar's tuition is paid, your scholar's seat will not be reserved and your scholar's schedule will not be created for the following school year.

STEP ONE:

Complete online re-enrollment forms in SchoolAdmin.

Please check your email on April 8th for the details and link.

STEP TWO:

- 1. Pay your scholar's remaining tuition balance in full for the 23-24 SY
- 2. Complete and submit the Cleveland/EdChoice Scholarship Renewal Form with a copy of recent full-page utility bill to Ms. Santiago

College Counseling Updates

COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA NOW!

The 2024-2025 FAFSA is open. All seniors must complete this application as it is a graduation/prom requirement and needed to receive financial aid for college. Parents will need an FSA ID. College counselors are available to assist with this application.

We recommend students do not make their college commitment until they have reviewed their financial aid award letters. These will be available in late March or early April because of the delay in FAFSA this year.

College Counselors are available to meet with families to review award letters and the college decision process.



Vision Screenings Next Week

As part of our commitment to ensuring the health and well-being of our students, we will be conducting vision screening for students in all grade levels. Screenings will take place on the following days:

- · Tuesday, April 16th for 9th and 11th grade
- · Wednesday, April 17th for 10th and 12th grade

Vision screenings are a valuable tool in identifying potential vision issues/concerns that may affect your child's learning and overall health. All of the above mentioned services will be provided and FREE of charge through our new partner, Vision to Learn, a non-profit organization that works to provide these vital services to students across the nation. Meningitis Vaccine Clinic for 11th Grade: April 22nd

On Monday, April 22nd, Saint Martin will host a Meningitis Vaccination clinic for ALL juniors and select seniors. All exemption statements for religious or personal reasons must be submitted to Mr. Khalil Brown at kbrown@stmdphs.org by May 10th.

Don't forget that as part of the re-enrollment process, all current 11th grade students will need to show proof of meningitis vaccine. The Ohio Revised Code requires all rising seniors to have a meningitis vaccine before returning to school in their senior year. Your student may have already received these immunizations at a previous medical appointment around the age of 16; please call to verify with your physician and obtain a copy of your immunization records to upload during reenrollment.

Prom Tickets


