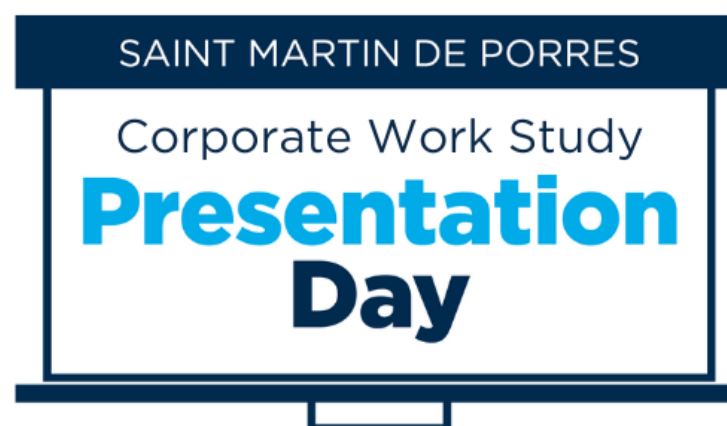

- **Wednesday, April 24th - Presentation Day Practice**

- **Friday, April 26th - Presentation Day**
  - ALL students are required to attend Presentation Day. This is a matriculation requirement.

- Students will be assigned a morning or afternoon presentation based on the Partner schedule.
- Students will be dismissed home after their presentation is complete.

### TWO-STEP RE-ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Please Note: All Financial Aid Commitments MUST BE PAID IN FULL prior to re-enrollment. Until the balance of your scholar's tuition is paid, your scholar's seat will not be reserved and your scholar's schedule will not be created for the following school year.

**STEP ONE:**

Complete online re-enrollment forms in SchoolAdmin.  
Please check your email on April 8th for the details and link.

**STEP TWO:**

1. Pay your scholar's remaining tuition balance in full for the 23-24 SY
2. Complete and submit the Cleveland/EdChoice Scholarship Renewal Form with a copy of recent full-page utility bill to Ms. Santiago

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## [College Counseling Updates](#)

### **COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA NOW!**

All seniors must complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA application as it is a graduation/prom requirement and needed to receive financial aid for college. College counselors are available to assist with this application.

**We recommend students do not make their college commitment until they have reviewed their financial aid award letters, which will be available in the next few weeks because of the FAFSA delays. Many colleges have adjusted their decision deadlines because of this.**

**College Counselors are available to meet with families to review award letters and the college decision process.**

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## [Meningitis Vaccine Clinic for 11th Grade: April 22nd](#)

On Monday, April 22nd, Saint Martin will host a Meningitis Vaccination clinic for ALL juniors and select seniors. All exemption statements for religious or personal reasons must be submitted to Mr. Khalil Brown at [kbrown@stmdphs.org](mailto:kbrown@stmdphs.org) by May 10th.

Don't forget that as part of the re-enrollment process, all current 11th grade students will need to show proof of meningitis vaccine. The Ohio Revised Code requires all rising seniors to have a meningitis vaccine before returning to school in their senior year. Your student may have already received these immunizations at a previous medical appointment around the age of 16; please call to verify with your physician and obtain a copy of your immunization records to upload during re-enrollment.

We will do a first round of ticket reservations beginning on May 6th for each graduate's family to reserve their first 8 seats. We will do a 2nd round of ticket reservations beginning on May 13th. The second round will allow for an unlimited number of reservations. Tickets will be sent digitally to each family.
