## End of Year Make-Up Time

Per our student handbook, **ALL missed CWSP workdays will require make-up time** to be completed by June 2022. *Failure to complete make-up time will result in a CWSP termination and \$80 fine for each make-up day not completed.*

### How to sign-up for Make-up Time

1. When a student is absent, they will receive an email from "notifications@workstudyforce.com"
2. Students must REQUEST a specific make-up day. The request will be sent to your supervisor for approval. Please note, that students may only request make-up time when school is NOT in session.
3. Here are some upcoming opportunities for make-up time:
  - Monday, June 13 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)
  - Tuesday, June 14 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)
  - Wednesday, June 15 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)

***If you need transportation for your CWSP make-up day, students must do two things:***

- Request a make-up day when transportation is available.

## Senior CWSP Requirements

In order to participate in year-end Senior events, students must complete ALL outstanding make-up time AND CWSP Presentation Day project.

- FINAL MAKE-UP WORKDAY & last opportunity for CWSP Presentation Day BEFORE PROM WILL BE Thursday, May 26, 2022.
- FINAL MAKE-UP WORKDAY and last opportunity for CWSP Presentation Day BEFORE GRADUATION WILL BE Thursday, June 2, 2022

Students with outstanding make-up time and/or missing CWSP Presentation Day project will not be permitted to participate in Prom or Graduation activities. Seniors should be attentive to making up missed time starting NOW in order to avoid finding themselves in difficult situations at the end of the school year. Make-up time requests must be approved by your CWSP supervisor. Failure to proactively request make-up time will not be excused.

## Senior Graduation & Prom Requirements

- **PROM:** Seniors must have all the following requirements complete to attend Prom:
  - FAFSA: must be complete and on file with College Counselling - this ensures students have financial eligibility for college enrollment and is aligned to our mission as a college preparatory school.
  - Capstone: requirements must be completed by Friday May 13th to be eligible to participate in Prom.
  - Corporate Work Study Make-Up Time
- **GRADUATION:**
  - To be eligible to participate in graduation events including the graduation ceremony, students must meet all requirements by Friday May 27th including attendance make-up (class and CWSP), credit recovery, FAFSA, and capstone.
  - To receive a Saint Martin Diploma, Seniors must complete any outstanding graduation requirements (i.e., credit recovery or capstone) by Thursday, June 30. After this date, students will be ineligible to receive a Saint Martin diploma and will be required to enroll in an alternative graduation program.

- Grades 9 - 11, progress reports will close Friday, April 29th and be distributed the week of May 2

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## 4th Quarter & Exam Dates

- Seniors: Last day of class is Friday, May 20 with exams on Monday & Tuesday May 23 & 24.
  - Grades 9 - 11: Last day of class is Tuesday, June 7th with exams on Wednesday & Thursday June 8 & 9.
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## Saturday School & After School Office Hours

- After School Office Hours continue Tuesday through Friday on the 2nd Floor of the Norwood Wing from 3:30 to 4:30 PM.
- Our next Saturday School coincides with the end of 4th quarter
  - May 28
  - June 4
- All students with After School Attendance Make-ups or currently on Academic Probation are expected to attend, until they resolve their outstanding attendance or academic issues. Seniors must attend Office Hours for Attendance Make-up.

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## Ohio Graduation Testing @ Saint Martin (IOWA)

All students in the state of Ohio are required to demonstrate competency in Algebra I and English 10 as well as "readiness" in 2 other areas to earn a diploma.

- Saint Martin will be conducting graduation testing on the following days:
  - All Ninth Graders: Thursday, May 5th
  - All Tenth Graders: Monday, May 9th
  - Select, as notified, 11th Graders: Saturday, May 14th
