## TWO-STEP RE-ENROLLMENT PROCESS

**Please Note: All Financial Aid Commitments MUST BE PAID IN FULL prior to re-enrollment. Until the balance of your scholar's tuition is paid, your scholar's seat will not be reserved and your scholar's schedule will not be created for the following school year.**

### STEP ONE:

Complete online re-enrollment forms in SchoolAdmin.  
Please check your email on April 8th for the details and link.

### STEP TWO:

1. Pay your scholar's remaining tuition balance in full for the 23-24 SY
2. Complete and submit the Cleveland/EdChoice Scholarship Renewal Form with a copy of recent full-page utility bill to Ms. Santiago

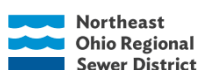
### WHAT TO BRING

In order to complete applications to enroll in assistance programs, you **must bring**:

- **Proof of household's total gross income** (e.g. paystub, social security, disability, pension letter, or most recently filed IRS 1040)
- **Birth certificate(s)**
- **ID (driver's license or state ID)**
- **Social Security Card**
- **Lease Agreement (if a renter)**
- **Supplemental Medical Insurance**
- **Current Electric Bill**
- **Current Gas Bill**
- **Current Water and Sewer Bills (if applicable)**
- **Bring COPIES of the above documentation for all members of your household**
