May is Asian & Pacific Islander Heritage Month!

Do you know about Saint Andrew Kim (1821-1846) and the martyrs of Korea? Andrew was the son of Christian converts who, upon his baptism at the age of 15, traveled to China to study for the priesthood. When he was ordained, six years later, he became the first native Korean priest. From a family of martyrs, Andrew would suffer martyrdom himself for the faith when he was arrested for attempting to bring Christian missionaries into Korea.

The Korean church suffered greatly in its early years yet continued to persevere, notably without the presence of many clergy. Andrew, the patron of Korean clergy, may be one of the more famous martyrs, but there were many others who were martyred for the faith, particularly in the nineteenth century. His feast day is September 20th and he shares his feast day with 98 other Koreans and other Christians who were canonized in 1984.
