End of Year Make-Up Time

Per our student handbook, ALL missed CWSP workdays will require make-up time to be completed by June 2022. Failure to complete make-up time will result in a CWSP termination and \$80 fine for each make-up day not completed.

How to sign-up for Make-up Time

1. When a student is absent, they will receive an email from "notifications@workstudyforce.com"
2. Students must REQUEST a specific make-up day. The request will be sent to your supervisor for approval. Please note, that students may only request make-up time when school is NOT in session.
3. Here are some upcoming opportunities for make-up time:
 - Monday, June 13 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)
 - Tuesday, June 14 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)
 - Wednesday, June 15 (TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE)

CWSP Work for Pay Details

SOME of our CWSP Partners offer summer Work-for-Pay. Meaning, you could continue your CWSP job over the summer and directly earn money. View the full work-for-pay details here.

Here are few important things to keep in mind:

- Decisions to hire a student over school breaks will be made by the CWSP Partner are based on:
 - Student work performance during the school year
 - Partner need for extra support over school breaks
 - Partner budget to pay a student over school breaks
- Students must speak directly with your supervisor to request summer work-for-pay. CWSP will not seek permission on your behalf, students must directly receive approval.
- Students with outstanding make-up time are NOT permitted to work for pay until make-up time is completed.
- Students will NOT be eligible to work-for-pay until all summer school credit recovery is completed.
- Students will need to provide their own transportation to and from all work-for-pay.

Course Selection Forms

- Course selection forms were shared with all students by email from Ms. Stacy Miller, please confirm that your student completed this process and have them contact Ms. Miller (smiller@stmdphs.org), if they have questions regarding their course selections.
 - Any student who does not submit a course selection form will be placed in classes based on graduation requirements and availability. Additionally, as a reminder, it is Saint Martin policy that all students take a "full academic course load" each semester (7 classes + CWSP placement) they are enrolled at school to earn a diploma. This maximizes students' college readiness and exceeds the State of Ohio requirements for graduation.

Semester 2 Exams

S2 Exams for all 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students are Wednesday, June 8 and Thursday, June 9th. All students are expected to attend and take their exams on their assigned exam days. Students may wear Saint Martin Spirit Wear or College Apparel on exam days. Students will be dismissed from school following completion of their 2nd exam.
