Students will not be allowed on campus this Fall if they do not have updated records.

Adjusted Schedule for IOWA Testing: May 11th

On Thursday, May 11th, Saint Martin will run a special schedule for students to accommodate IOWA Assessments.

- All **9th grade students** should report to campus by 7:50 to complete their IOWA Assessments. 9th Grade will be dismissed at 2:00 PM.
- **10 & 11th Grade Students**: Please be on the lookout for an email regarding your schedule on May 11th.
 - Students who have met graduation requirements do not need to report to school on May 11th.
 - Students who have NOT met the requirements will report to campus by 7:50 AM to complete the necessary IOWA assessments. Students who need to be present should see their email for their individual dismissal times; final dismissal for students will be 2:00 PM.
 - 11th Grade Students no longer need to report to Saturday School on May 6th for IOWA testing.
- **12th Grade Students** should report to school as usual by 7:50 AM for their Corporate Work Study day.
