CWSP Begins in September!

Students will begin reporting to their CWSP Placements after Labor Day! Below are the student workdays and respective first days of work.

- Freshmen Workday = MONDAYS
 - First day; Monday, September 13
- Sophomore Workday = TUESDAYS
 - First day; Tuesday, September 7
- Junior Workday = WEDNESDAYS
 - First day; Wednesday, September 8
- Senior Workday = THURSDAYS
 - First day; Thursday, September 9
- *FRIDAYS will operate on a rotation schedule.*

Freshmen Professional Development:

In order to ensure our Freshmen students are fully prepared for their first Corporate Work Study Program placement, all freshmen will participate in CWSP Professional Development! Beginning Monday, September 13, freshmen will prepare for a future deployed placement by practicing and enhancing their professionalism, leadership, and workplace skills.

Work Permit Physicals:

All Freshmen AND Sophomore students must receive a pre-work physical (conducted at Saint Martin with our partners from MetroHealth). *These physicals are required in order to issue the student's Work Permit.*

- Sophomore Physicals: The week of August 16.
- Freshmen Physicals: First two weeks of September.


