Mother Laura Montoya (1874-1949) was Colombia's first saint. She was an educator who worked tirelessly to confront racial discrimination and to sacrifice herself in order to help the people of Colombia encounter Christ's love.

Mother Laura felt that God was calling her to tell all people about His love, especially people that others ignored or looked down upon so she left the city to live and teach in the jungles of Colombia. Life in the jungle was hard, especially when Mother Laura was older and had to be in a wheelchair because of an illness, but she was remained joyful and generous, never leaving the jungle or the people she loved so much.

We celebrate her feast day on October 21. She is the patron saint of orphans and anyone who feels left out.
