Vaccine \$\$\$ Bonus for CWSP

Students who receive a NEW vaccination or booster shot will receive a CASH bonus from CWSP.

Eligibility & Terms:

- NEW Vaccines (fully) or Booster Shots are received after June 9th, 2022, and BEFORE January 1, 2023.
- Full vaccines = \$100 Bonus
- Boosters = \$50 Bonus

COVID Policy Guidelines

We want to keep our campus, open, healthy, and have the least amount of restrictions as possible. To do so, we need your help to ensure that the procedures outlined below are followed:

Staying Home

Students should STAY HOME if they are feeling ill or have 2-3 of the following symptoms:

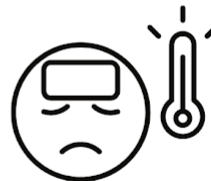
Cough, Sore Throat	Vomiting, nausea, diarrhea
Fever, chills	New loss of taste or smell
Body Aches, Fatigue, Tiredness	Shortness of breath

Please **DO NOT** send students to school until they are feeling better and are symptom free.

At School

Students who are at school and showing 2-3 of the symptoms in the chart:

- Will need to be picked up from school within 1-2 hours or less.
- Will be sent home with a COVID test (as available)



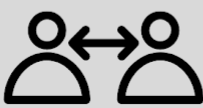
If your student has been sent home:

- he/she may return to school as soon as they show: proof of a negative COVID test AND are no longer feeling ill/showing symptoms.

Sanitize phones and wash hands regularly.



Avoid unnecessary close contact whenever possible.



Comply with wearing masks in close quarters including CWSP vans and school transportation



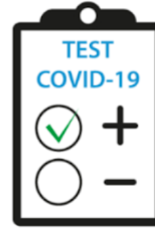
Know that additional measures may become necessary if we see increases in cases as the year progresses.



Testing Positive & Quarantine

If your student tests positive for COVID:

- Let us know, and the date they tested
- They will need to [stay home for 5 CALENDAR days](#), AND until they are [feeling better/symptom free](#).



Students returning after five days will be asked to [wear a mask](#) on campus until [10 days](#) after their positive test.

Students on athletic teams may return to practice after 5 days, but [will not be able to participate until after 10 days from their positive test](#).

Temporary Instruction

Any student sent home and unable to return within one day, or who are quarantined for 5 days will receive a temporary instruction plan allowing:

- Absences to be excused during this period
- [5 days of extended time](#) to complete [major assignments](#) (papers, tests/quizzes, projects, etc) assignments.
- All other work will be excused and only graded when it helps the student's overall grade
- All work will be accessible on [Google Classroom](#).

See You in Office Hours!

Office Hours take place daily from 3:30 to 4:30 on the second floor math commons. Office hours are open to all students and there will be a teacher available in all content areas every day of the week. Students on Academic Probation are required to attend at least 2 days a week and all others are encouraged to come for assistance on upcoming papers, projects, quizzes, tests or to just stay up-to-date on your most recent classwork.

MetroHealth Care for Students During the School Day
The Institute for H.O.P.E. School Health Program is partnering with your school district to offer health care services on-site at your child's school. Your child will now have easier medical service access during the school day.

What services does MetroHealth provide?

- Annual physicals
- Sports physicals
- Injury/illness care
- Routine lab tests
- Prescription medications
- Teen services
- Mental/behavioral health
- Immunizations
- Care for chronic conditions, including asthma, allergies, diabetes and seizure disorders
- Health education and prevention
- Telehealth, to supplement in-person care

How can my child participate?
Complete the Institute for H.O.P.E. School Health Program consent packet at metrohealth.org/school-health or at your school office. The program is open to all students who have a signed parental consent form on file, which remains valid while the child attends school in the district.

Tuition/School Fees Update

An invoice will be **e-mailed** home for the payment of Tuition/School Fees for the 2022-2023 School Year on September 1st, 2022. **The first payment is due on September, 10th, 2022.** Late fees of \$25.00 will be applied to unpaid balances.

The following forms will be mailed home and need to be completed and **returned to Ms. Santiago in the Business Office no later than September 9th, 2022.**

- **Voucher Check - Signature Agreement:** If the school has this completed form on file for your student, you will not have to come into the school each month to sign the voucher check for scholarships CSTP, EDChoice or Expansion.
