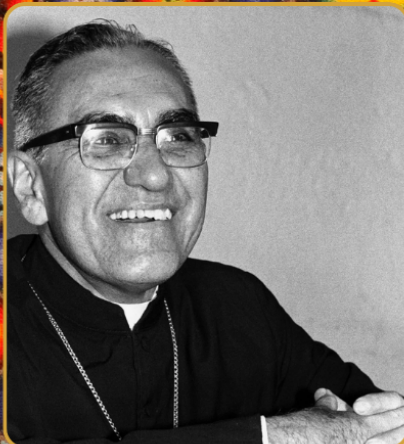

### ST. OSCAR ROMERO



St. Oscar Romero (1917-1980) was a weak, bookish priest from El Salvador for most of his adult life. Ordained at 24, he served as a parish priest for over 20 years. He was diagnosed with obsessive compulsive personality disorder by a psychiatrist as well as struggling with scrupulosity. Shortly after he became archbishop of San Salvador, a Jesuit priest who was a close friend of Archbishop Romero's was murdered for his work with the poor. This moment changed Romero's life; he later said, "When I looked at Rutilio lying there dead I thought, 'If they have killed him for doing what he did, then I too have to walk the same path.'" Romero began to speak out against human rights abuses perpetrated by the government, particularly during his weekly radio sermons. On March 24, 1980, he was gunned down while celebrating Mass. He was canonized a saint in 2018.
