



CWSP Timecards

Students will receive a digital timecard via email EACH WORKDAY. Timecards are an important reflection of your work and contributions to the organization each week, they are also a legal record of your hours worked.

Students have 24 hours to complete their CWSP timecards. Grades will be updated weekly and late timecards are not accepted.

Q1 CWSP Project: DUE TODAY!

The Corporate Work Study Program is an integral part of a Saint Martin education. Therefore, students will not only receive quarterly CWSP project, but they will also receive a GRADE each

quarter.

The Q1 CWSP Project has been posted in google classroom for ALL STUDENTS. It is due TODAY!

The project will require that you take photos on your workday and use them to create a photo journal in google slides. Detailed instructions are available in Google Classroom.

CWSP Grades

Students will receive a Corporate Work Study grade based on performance in their CWSP workday, which includes attendance, completion of CWSP workday assignments, and compliance with CWSP standards and procedures.

- Timecards = 20%
- Quarterly CWSP Projects = 20%
- Supervisor Evaluations = 60%

The CWSP grade is GPA-bearing and passing the class is a graduation requirement.

- Friday Saint Martin Spirit Wear & Senior Custom Day


Homecoming Dance Information
