The dress code policy ensures that every student will dress in a professional, modest, conservative and safe manner consistent with the Work and Faith pillars of our school values. Saint Martin de Porres High School's dress code policy corresponds to business attire and the image that we have determined is appropriate for young men and women representing the school community. When they go to work or school, students enter a professional work environment. Their dress should reflect a high standard of professionalism and self-respect.

There are only two options for dress at Saint Martin: Standard Dress Code worn by all students on Monday through Thursday and Friday Spirit Wear/College Apparel Days.



WHAT'S NEW? Uniform Beginning August 2025

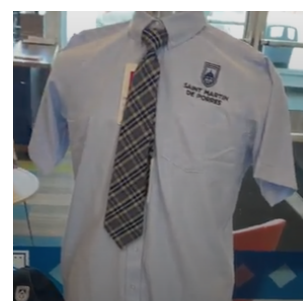
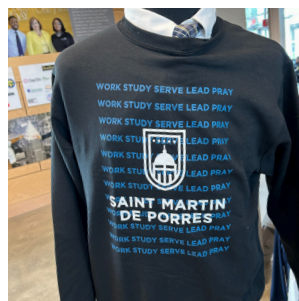
- Uniform logo items are limited to the items pictured below.

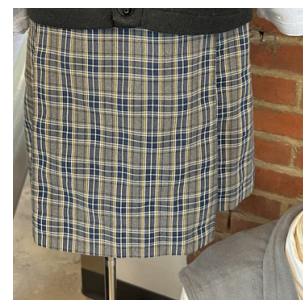

STANDARD DRESS CODE REQUIRED MONDAY through THURSDAY FOR ALL STUDENTS

Dress code options can be worn in any combination chosen by the student.

NEW FOR 25-26!

LOGO ITEM

- Students must have a visible Saint Martin logo on them limited to the following forms:
 - Crewneck Pullover in Navy Blue, Grey, or Black w/Crest Logo
 - Logo Tie
 - Plaid Skirt for girls
 - Logo Button Down Shirt
 - Saint Martin Cardigan or Sweater Vest
- All other Saint Martin items are restricted to Friday Spirit Wear Day.

SHIRT

- Dress Shirt, collared, button-down, white or light blue (long or short sleeve)
- Can also be logo button down shirt

BOTTOMS

- BLACK or GREY Pants (No Jeans, Leggings, Capris or Shorts)
- SM PLAID UNIFORM SKIRT for girls - no other skirt options are permitted
 - Skirts require biker shorts underneath and must be appropriate length

SHOES & ACCESSORIES

- ALL BLACK Professional Style Shoes (No crocs, foam based shoes, open-toed shoes, flip flops, slides, slippers (uggs), house shoes, etc.)
- Vans, Loafer Sneakers, and other soft bottom professional shoes in all black are permitted
- Belt must be worn with pants that have belt loops (no sagging permitted)

HAIR COLOR

- Hair color must be a shade that human hair would naturally grow.

FRIDAY ONLY Spirit Wear & College Apparel ATTIRE FOR ALL STUDENTS

Each Friday, students must have at least one significant item of school spirit wear on (This includes items from athletics/activities and/or items from the Lion's Den. Hats, buttons, scarves, ties, stickers, etc do not count as a significant spirit wear item).

TOPS

- Acceptable Spirit Wear Attire: SM Class T-Shirts, Athletic Uniforms/Spirit Items, Scholarship Items, Saint Martin Hoodies, I Got In shirt, other Saint Martin Logo Items OR College/University Logo items may be worn.
- Clothing must appropriately represent Saint Martin or other College/University - No other wording/logos permitted
- Shoulders, midriffs, and cleavage should be covered
- No crop-tops, see-through, spaghetti straps, tube tops, and no undergarments showing

BOTTOMS

- Saint Martin Gear
- Jeans & sweatpants are acceptable
 - Rips/tears in jeans should fall at the knee or below
 - Skirts are acceptable but must fall at the knee or below
 - Absolutely no shorts

SHOES & ACCESSORIES

- Shoes must be closed-toed.
 - No crocs, foam based shoes, open-toed shoes, flip flops, slides, slippers (uggs), house shoes, etc.
 - Tennis shoes, Toms, boots, and loafers are all acceptable.
 - No hats or sunglasses of any kind
 - All hair accessories must be appropriate for a professional setting at all times and during school and work assignments. Head wraps and scarves that reflect religious styles are permitted. Protective hair coverings are not permitted to be worn such as scarves, bonnets, and durags.
